Planning Application: P/11/01132/F – Hutchins Farm, Horley Row

A member of the public, Ms H Woodhouse, requested that the Town Council re-consider comments previously made regarding the above Application. As a resident of a neighbouring property, she felt that the proposed raised roof would be out of keeping with nearby properties and the planned windows on the eastern side would have an impact on the privacy of her own property. She also thought that the Application was contrary to Local Plan Policies, which were designed to protect the amenities of adjoining properties, maintain privacy and protect the character of the area. There were several other matters which were covered by a supporting document. The Chairman thanked the resident for her input. He added that, with the additional information produced by the resident, the Town Council was now in a position to make further comments on the Application.

P 3361 Cllr Jack Chapman expressed his concerns about some apparent inconsistencies in Planning Application decisions made by the Borough Council as the Local Planning Authority, in particular with reference to the granting of Certificates of Lawfulness. Cllr Richard Olliver explained that there were specific reasons why a Certificate of Lawfulness may be granted, usually to confirm that an extension was permissible and had not required planning permission. He referred members to The Planning Portal which, amongst other things, specified which elements of extensions were allowed without planning permission.

P 3362 The Clerk reported receipt of preliminary information from Waldon Telecom Ltd, regarding a proposed Telecoms Mast in Hevers Avenue, to increase and improve mobile phone coverage in the Horley Row and Meath Green areas.

P 3363 North East Sector

The Chairman referred to recent concerns about campers in fields adjacent to land where houses were being built by Barratts Homes. The fields were believed to be under the ownership of Barratts. It was noted that the matter was currently being investigated by the Police, and that the Borough Council had sent officers to check for any damage to trees. Members were also informed that BT Open World would shortly be updating broadband in the area.

P 3364 Town Centre Regeneration

It was noted that some repairs to the paving outside the Jack Fairman Public House had been made, following concerns raised at the last meeting of the Horley Regeneration Forum. There had also been some repairs to paving in the pedestrian area, although the overall standard there was far from satisfactory.
