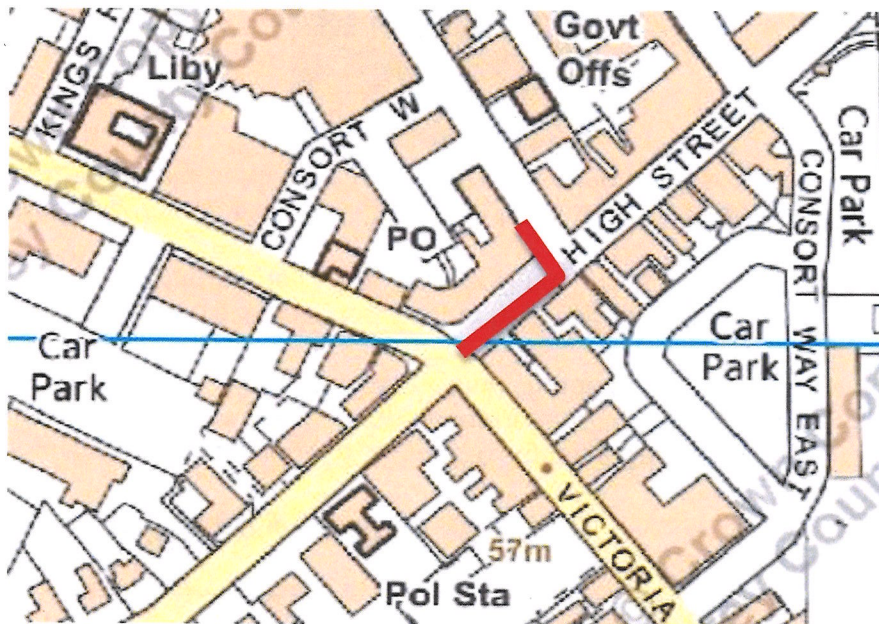

### What are we going to do?

We are making major improvements to the Pedestrian Precinct in the High Street.

The works include resurfacing, new lighting, new street furniture, drainage improvements, and better loading and unloading arrangements for deliveries.

### Information for residents and businesses

This work will be carried out in sections along the pedestrian area of the High Street between Albert Road and Victoria Road. The area will remain open under 24 hour restricted access. Temporary traffic lights will be required at times on Albert Road and Victoria Road.

**Pedestrian access will be maintained and businesses will be operating as usual throughout these works.**

Works will take place Monday to Friday from 7:30am – 6pm and Saturday from 8am – 6pm. Some night work may be required and there may be times when 24 hour working is taking place. We will endeavour to notify you in advance if either of these are required.

The red line on the map opposite indicates the extent of works.

The car parks in the area will be open for use as usual.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

### Delays in work
