The original plan leaned more towards using machinery to do the excavations however this had to be altered to avoid the risk of striking cables and services underground.

The contractors, Kier, had assured SCC that the extension to September was to cover all eventualities, and the emphasis is on seeking to reduce this extension where possible and keep this to a minimum.

P 6437 Surrey Fire and Rescue Service - Making Surrey Safer plan 2020 - 2023 Consultation (Closing Date 26 May 2019)

The Chairman gave an overview of the consultation. He highlighted that there were proposals to reduce the number of fire appliances and stations available overnight, a period from 6:00 pm to 8:00 am. Proposals included the closure of Banstead overnight and the plan to rely on other counties for back up. A member expressed concern that that 6:00 pm was the time when people were cooking dinners etc and surely this was a peak time for fire alarms. Another concern was about what would happen if there was more than one serious incident at a time. The Chairman noted that according to statistics, fire incidents were not more prevalent at this time and if local authority areas merged there might be better resources under a central control similar to SECAMB.

RESOLVED: that the Chairman draft a response for ratification at the next meeting of the Planning Committee.

Cllr Olliver said that these surveys were designed for individual residents and that it was not appropriate for the Council, as an organisation, to give a blanket response. However, a letter would be sent to Healthwatch expressing concerns about the level of healthcare, particularly GPs, available in Horley and stating that the Council would welcome an opportunity to discuss the issues further.
