# P 5798 Horley High Street Public Realm Improvements

# P 5800 SCC Temporary Closure Oder: Public Footpath 411 (North East of Landens Farm, Horley)

The Planning Officer reported receipt of the above SCC Temporary Closure Order on Footpath No. 411, at North East of Landens Farm, now in place until 14 January 2018, to facilitate construction works.

#### P 5801 SCC Road Maintenance in Horley

The Planning Officer advised that increasing concerns raised by the committee on outstanding road maintenance in Horley reaching a critical stage, had been conveyed in writing to the South East Area Highways Manager. This particularly related to Victoria Road which only had temporary repairs carried out to certain pot holes with others left untreated which was thought to be inadequate to sustain the road surface.

Further concerns were also raised about a series of sunken holes rapidly appearing more recently. In order to appraise the general condition of the road, it was further requested that SCC Highways Officers consent to a tour of the area along with Town Councillors, who would point out the worst affected areas. A further update would be provided once a response had been received from Surrey Highways.

RESOLVED: that a further update on outstanding road maintenance be provided at the next meeting of this Committee.

## P 5802 Part Night Lighting Review Request: Riverside Cycle Path

The Clerk reported that since the implementation of **Part Night Lighting Programme** across the borough, the SCC Street Lighting Manager advised that a higher than anticipated volume of requests to review certain streets had been received, and these were now being processed in chronological order. As requested by the Town Council, an update on a request to review Riverside Cycle Path would be processed and the outcome would be sent to the office as soon as possible. Cllr Mabbett added that more lights were switched off in the location, leading from 'The Crescent' towards the airport, and this would be reported similarly to SCC Highways as a safety concern.
